Opening Devotion

Chaplain Caleb Schaller led a devotion based on Mark 3:13-19. This Scripture section announces those chosen by Christ to serve as His apostles. By examining what we know about those choices it becomes clear that Christ did not choose them because of their pureness or intelligence, rather He chose them to save them from their sins and to save others through their gospel proclamation.

So it is with us. We share the same weaknesses and pitfalls of those early apostles. Yet Christ, by His grace, has called us to save us and through us to proclaim the gospel. The success of our work is not because of us, but due to our connection to Him.

Devotion concluded with the singing of selected stanzas of “While Yet the Morn is Breaking.”
