CLC Funds

General fund: Offerings to missions support the day-to-day operations of both the CLC mission program and Immanuel Lutheran College.

Mission Development Fund (MDF): This fund supports mission projects which are normally limited-term, such as buying Bibles and Catechisms, roofing foreign churches, and purchasing motorcycles and bicycles for pastors.

Immanuel Improvement Fund (IIF): Money in this fund is used for major campus maintenance projects, as well as other needs which are not part of the regular operating budget.

ILC Student Aid: This fund provides loans and grants to students in both the high school and college departments. The fund is available to all ILC students synod-wide.

ILC Building Fund: The fund was established for the construction of an academic center. Ongoing contributions are needed to service the mortgage.

Kinship: This fund was begun initially to support orphans in our foreign mission fields. In addition, it is now used to assist foreign seminary students.

MEF: This is a revolving fund designed to provide loans to CLC institutions and congregations for building construction and other capital improvements.
